A BILL

To support hospital-based nursing and allied health education associated with services to Medicare Advantage beneficiaries during the novel coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) public health emergency.

Be it enacted by the House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

Section 1. SHORT TITLE

This Act may be cited as the “[insert title].”

Sec 2. [TITLE – DELAY IMPLEMENTATION OF CMS INSTRUCTION FOR 180 DAYS]

Notwithstanding any provision of the Medicare Act, of the Social Security, or of Public Law 106-113 or 106-554, the Secretary shall not, before 180 days from the enactment of this statute, use the figures promulgated in CMS Manual System Publication 100-20 (also known as Transmittal 10315 or Change Request 11642) as the basis for calculating any payment to a provider pursuant to 42 U.S.C. 1395ww(l) or recalculating any such payment from a period before the enactment of this statute; shall not promulgate any other figures to be used to calculate or recalculate such past payments; and shall not recover or reclaim any payments previously made or under that provision.
